Award of Contract for the
**PROCUREMENT OF TECHNICAL SERVICES FOR THE CONDUCT OF SOIL
INVESTIGATION AT SELECTED PORTS (PACKAGE 7)**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) advertised a Request for Expression of Interest for the Procurement of Technical Services for the Conduct of Soil Investigation at Selected Ports (Package 7), in the Manila Standard, a newspaper of general nationwide circulation on 27 October 2016 and posted the same in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and at a conspicuous place in the PPA premises, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as published/advertised is **₱ 20,979,211.38**;

WHEREAS, in response thereto, two (2) consulting firms secured and submitted their duly accomplished Eligibility Documents within the prescribed deadline for submission thereof, namely:

1. Syconsult, Incorporated
2. R.S. Jardin and Associates

WHEREAS, after the Eligibility Screening conducted on 10 November 2016, the two (2) consultants were declared eligible to bid for the project, as shown on the attached Checklist of Eligibility Requirements (Annex "A");

WHEREAS, considering that two (2) consultants were declared eligible to bid for the project and the required number of shortlisted consultants as advertised should be not more than five (5), the two (2) eligible consultants were automatically considered as shortlisted, pursuant to Head Office-Engineering Projects – Consultancy Resolution No. CON 002-2016 Series of 2016, dated 10 November 2016, attached as Annex "B";

WHEREAS during the opening of the Technical Proposal (First Envelope) conducted on 08 December 2016, the two (2) bidders passed the requirements of the First Envelope, as shown on the attached Checklist of Bidding Documents (Annex "C");

WHEREAS, the Technical Proposals of the two (2) bidders were evaluated using the approved criteria for evaluation to determine its rating, as follows:

and after due deliberation by the BAC the two (2) bidders were declared as “passed;”

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposals of the two (2) bidders were opened on 13 December 2016 and declared “passing” with the requirements of the Second Envelope, hence their financial bids were read by the Chairperson, as follows: (Copy of the Abstract of Bids As Read attached as Annex “D”);

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial bids and calculation of the final scores, taking into consideration the technical and financial ratings, the following ratings were arrived at: (Copy of the Results of Technical and Financial Evaluation attached as Annex “E”);

WHEREAS, Bid Evaluation was conducted on 14 December 2016 to determine arithmetical or computational errors on the bid proposals of the bidders and the Bid Evaluation Report (Copy attached as Annex “F”), which was approved by the BAC on 15 December 2016, showed discrepancies on the bid proposal of R.S. Jardin and Associates, as shown in the following table. (Copy of the Abstract of Bids as Calculated attached as Annex “G”);

WHEREAS, R.S. Jardin and Associates was declared as the Highest Rated Bidder in the amount of ₱ 20,454,827.90, pursuant to Section 34.4 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 (Copy of the Abstract of Bids as Calculated attached as Annex "H");

WHEREAS, Post-qualification was conducted on 16 December 2015 to examine, validate and verify the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by R.S. Jardin and Associates and in the Post-Qualification Report (Copy attached as Annex "I"), approved by the BAC on 20 December 2016, R.S. Jardin and Associates was declared as the Highest Rated and Responsive Bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to declare **R.S. JARDIN AND ASSOCIATES** as the Highest Rated and Responsive Bidder and to recommend the award of contract for the Procurement of Technical Services for the Conduct of Soil Investigation at Selected Ports (Package 7), in the amount of **TWENTY MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN AND 90/100 PESOS (₱ 20,454,827.90)**, inclusive of taxes, to the said bidder.
