SUBJECT : GUIDELINES ON PILOTAGE RATES AND PPA REVENUE FROM
PILOTAGE SERVICE

1. AUTHORITY

1.1 Sections 6(a)(VIII) and 20 of PD 857, as amended by
LOI No. 1005-A

1.2 Section 23 of PPA AO No. 03-85

2. SCOPE

This Order shall cover all Harbor Pilots/Pilots'
Associations operating in the 24 pilotage districts of the
country.

3. OBJECTIVE

To enable the Authority to collect additional revenue for
the improvement of port facilities and services.

4. PURPOSE

To prescribe guidelines on the generation of government
revenue from pilotage service through PPA collection of
government share from pilotage income.

5. GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are hereby issued for the
compliance of all concerned:

5.1 Pilotage Rates - The applicable rates for regular pilotage services rendered to vessels are as follows:

5.1.1 Foreign Vessels -

5.2 Gross Income - For purposes of this Order, the term "gross income" shall be understood to mean as total gross billings (whether already realized or still to be collected) assessed the shipping agents/vessel owners for the conduct of regular and other related special pilotage services.

5.3 PPA Revenue - In consideration of the privilege to render pilotage service and to use port facilities, all Harbor Pilots/Pilots' Associations shall remit to the Authority, through the Port Management Office (PMO), a government share of not less than ten (10%) percent of their gross income derived from purely pilotage service. The 10% government share for billings which have already been realized/collected shall be remitted to the PMO not later than the tenth (10th) day of the succeeding month. Billings which

are still to be collected by the pilots (receivables) shall, subsequently, be subject to 10% government share upon collection and shall also be remitted to the PMO not later than the tenth (10th) day of the succeeding month. In either case, late payments by the harbor pilots/pilots' associations shall be subject to interest and penalties as prescribed in PPA AO No. 08-82.

The above remittance scheme shall be without prejudice to PPA's right to subsequently impose, if warranted, a direct collection system (on a per vessel basis) in any pilotage district.

5.4 Records - The Pilotage Association shall keep records of its transactions and furnish the Authority with copies of its billings and receipts in accordance with the provisions of Sections 19 and 21 of PPA AO No. 03-85.

5.5 Audit - The Association shall make available, for audit by the Authority, all financial records and all other records concerning its operations.

6. REPEALING CLAUSE


All PPA orders, rules and regulations, circulars or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If, for any reason, any section or part of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, the declared or invalid section or part thereof shall not affect the other sections or parts to which such declaration or nullity does not apply or relate.

8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
