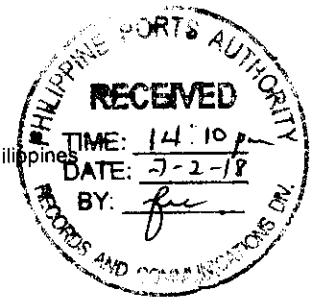

SUBJECT : Approved Increase on the Present Cargo Handling (CH)
Charges at the Port of Dapitan

Pursuant to Board Resolution No.2706, a cargo handling rate increase of **3%** on the present CH charges at the Port of Dapitan is hereby approved in addition to the 10% provisional increase granted in 2013.

This increase to be implemented in one (1) tranche shall be effective 30 days after publication of this Circular in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
