Guidelines in Handling Flat Racks

Flat racks refers to a type of shipping container which has no sides or top It is designed to accommodate cargoes, such as machinery, vehicles or forestry products whose overall dimensions exceed those of a general purpose container. As there were queries as to the treatment of empty flat racks, the following guidelines are hereby issued.

- Bundled flat racks (e.g. three or four empty flat racks in one bundle) are classified as empty containers
- For billing purposes, a bundle of three (3) or four (4) empty flat racks is considered as one (1) lift
- The rate of a 20 foot empty container under item A 1 of containerized cargo in the cargo handling tariff schedule of MICT and South Harbor shall be the basis in the assessment of per lift of empty flat racks
- 4 The productivity rate of 22 moves per crane hour shall be observed
