**SUBJECT :** Amendment to PPA Operations Memorandum Circular (OMC) No. 03-2010


To ensure the correct assessment of per lift of bundled flat racks, PPA OMC No. 03-2010 is hereby amended to read, as follows:

- “3. *Three to four empty flat racks in one bundle should be billed as one unit and the rate shall be based on laden rates, such that:*
- *Three or four 20-foot empty flat racks bundled as one unit shall be assessed the 20-foot laden rate;*
  - *Three or four 40-foot empty flat racks bundled as one unit shall be assessed the 40-foot laden rate”.*

A revised schedule of cargo handling tariff at MICT and South Harbor will be disseminated reflecting therein the rates of 20-foot and 40-foot empty flat racks.

All other guidelines prescribed under PPA OMC No. 01-2007 remain valid.

This Circular takes effect immediately.
