No. 05-2001

Operations Memorandum Order (OMO) No 03-2002 was issued to clarify issues on the proper implementation of the rate adjustment and the crane productivity rate. There was, however a request to amend the OMO by adding a provision to deduct from the crane productivity of the terminal operator, the actual time spent for moving/shifting and securing the ship s crane.

  - 3 3.9 The actual time spent for moving/shifting and securing the ship's crane shall be deducted from the crane productivity of the terminal operator.
