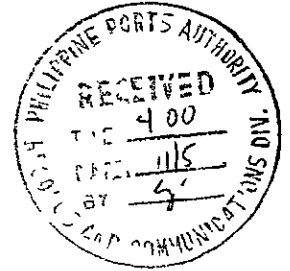



**S U B J : Applicable RO-RO Tariff Rates for the
Ferry Ports under the Expanded SRNH 2**

In view of the inauguration by Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo of the Second-Phase of the Strong Republic Nautical Highway (SRNH2), the applicable RO-RO Tariff Rates embodied in PPA Memorandum Circular No 17-2003, dated 16 July 2003 (Annex A), is hereby prescribed for use at the SRNH2-identified ferry ports (Annex B), under the same terms and conditions

This Memorandum Circular shall be published twice in a newspaper of general circulation and shall take effect 15 days from the date of last publication

This Memorandum Circular shall remain in full force and effect unless otherwise amended or revoked by competent authority

S U B J Applicable RO-RO Tariff Rates for the
Strong Republic Nautical Highway (SRNH)

In order to support and complement the operation and realization of the PGMA's Strong Republic Nautical Highway as a means to bolster inter-island trade and promote tourism, the following RO-RO Tariff (Ceiling) Rates, to be used in the SRNH Ferry Ports, are hereby prescribed, as follows

<u>Vehicle Type</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Terminal Fee</u>
Type 1	Motorcycle, Tricycle, Scooter	P 50 00
Type 2	Car, Minivan, SUV, AUV, Owner Jeep, PUJ (up to 16 pax)	100 00
Type 3	Light Delivery Van, Pick-up Truck, PUJ (more than 16 pax),	200 00
Type 4	Stake Truck, Heavy Delivery Truck, Passenger/Tourist Bus Prime Mover/Tractor Head (with or without Trailer/chassis)	400 00

The above rates shall be an inclusive charge for the use of the port facilities and services and shall be collected by the PPA on a per sea-leg journey at the port of loading or embarkation

In ports where the present Terminal Fee assessed on vehicle owners are lower than the above ceiling rates, the lower rates may continue to be applied and collected

No other fees or charges shall be collected at the port of discharge or debarkation
