The Philippine Ports Authority - Port Management Office of Batangas, through its Bids and Awards Committee for Engineering Projects, invites contractors registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) to bid for the hereunder contract:

Brief Description : The project involves repair of service road along turning basin and depressed section at north – west portion it includes demolition & disposal of existing pavement (1,393 m²), removal & disposal of existing asphalt pavement including unsuitable base materials (1,991 m³), supply, spread & compact aggregate sub-base materials (492 m³) & base course materials (492 m³), supply & placed portland cement concrete pavement (PCCP) 300 mm thk. (1,428 m²) & 200 mm thk. (2,028 m²) and, provision of concrete guardhouse (4 units).

Only those contractors with PCAB Registration of at least “Small ‘B’ for Ports, Harbor and Offshore Engineering” will be issued Bidding Documents, and upon payment of non-refundable cost of the documents in the amount of PHP 28,000.00 inclusive of VAT. Interested contractors are required to present a certified copy of their PCAB registration when purchasing the Bidding Documents.

Prospective bidders should possess a valid PCAB license and registration particulars applicable to the type and cost of the contract to be bid, have key personnel and equipment available for the prosecution of the contract as listed above, and must have completed a contract similar to the contract to be bid and with the same major categories of work as the contract to be bid, and completed within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids with a value of at least 50% of the approved budget for the contract to be bid, updated to current prices using the NSO price indices, and must meet the other eligibility and bid requirements stated in the Eligibility Statement Form and Bidding Documents.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criteria as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least 75% interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.


