



## INVITATION TO BID

The Philippine Ports Authority - Port Management Office of Batangas, through its Bids and Awards Committee, invites contractors registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) to bid for the hereunder contract:

Name of Contract : Repair/Repainting of Damaged Port Facilities

Location : Port of Nasugbu, Batangas

Brief Description : The project involves repair of damaged bulkhead it includes retrieval & reinstallation of rocks on collapsed bulkhead, supply and place of class III rocks (50 – 100 kgs.- 660 cum.) and reinforced concrete for covering of bulkhead (75 cu.m.), repair/repainting of pre-cast perimeter fence (149 ln.m.), passenger terminal building and welcome arch & steel gates, repair of one (1) unit high mast tower with four(4) sets 250W-LED floodlights fixtures, two(2) units reinforced concrete guardhouse and, one (1) unit - 4,000 lit. stainless water tank with reinforced concrete platform and solar powered water supply system.

Required PCAB Registrations: **Small "B" – for Ports, Harbor & Offshore Eng'ng.**

Only those contractors with PCAB Registration of at least “Small ‘B’ for Ports, Harbor & Offshore Engineering” will be issued Bidding Documents, and upon payment of non-refundable cost of the documents in the amount of PHP 28,000.00 inclusive of VAT. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids. Interested contractors are required to present a certified copy of their PCAB registration when purchasing the Bidding Documents.

Prospective bidders should possess a valid PCAB license and registration particulars applicable to the type and cost of the contract to be bid, have key personnel and equipment available for the prosecution of the contract as listed above, and must have completed at least one (1) contract that is similar to the contract to be bid, and with the same major categories of work as the contract to be bid, and whose value is at least 50% of the approved budget for the contract to be bid, updated to current prices using the NSO consumer price indices. Prospective bidders must likewise meet the other eligibility, technical/project and financial requirements and other requirements stated in the Eligibility Statement Forms and the Bidding Documents.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criteria as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least 75% interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
