

## INVITATION TO BID

FOR THE:

### REPAIR OF BREAKWATER NO.1/BERTH NO.1 PORT OF LEGAZPI CITY

1. The *Philippine Ports Authority – Port Management Office of Bicol*, through the *PPA Corporate Budget of the Authority for CY 2020*, intends to apply the sum of *Twenty-Six Million Four Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-One Thousand and Sixty-Five Centavos (P 26, 482,461.65)* being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Repair of Breakwater No.1/Berth No.1, Port of Legazpi City**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Philippine Ports Authority- PMO-Bicol now invites bids for the following Scope of Works:
  - Item No.1 General Expenses**
    - 1.1 Mobilization/Demobilization and Cleaning
  - Item No.2 Damaged Structures**
    - 2.1 Demolition and Disposal of Damaged Deflector Wall
    - 2.2 Demolition and Disposal of Damaged Curtin Wall, RC Curb and removal of four bollards
  - Item No.3 Deflector Wall**
    - 3.1 Supply and deliver to site type II Steel Sheet Piles
    - 3.2 Handle, pitch and drive type II Steel Sheet Piles
    - 3.3 Supply and place 50-100kg Core Rocks
    - 3.4 Supply and install steel reinforcements
    - 3.5 Supply and place 3500psi Concrete Deflector Wall
  - Item No.4 Curtin Wall, RC Curb and Mooring Block**
    - 4.1 Supply and install steel reinforcements
    - 4.2 Supply and place 3500psi Concrete
  - Item No.5 PCCP**
    - 5.1 Supply, spread and compact aggregate base course
    - 5.2 Construct PCCP (300mm thk.)
  - Item No.6 Mooring Bollard**
    - 6.1 Supply and deliver to site 50T Mooring Bollard
    - 6.2 Install 50T Mooring Bollard
  - Item No.7 Rubber Dock Fender**
    - 7.1 Removal of damaged RDF accessories
    - 7.2 Supply and deliver to site V-type 500H x 2000L Rubber Dock Fender
    - 7.3 Install V-type 500H x 2000L RDF

Completion of the Works is required in **Two Hundred Ten (210) Calendar Days**. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary **“Pass/Fail”** criterion as also specified in the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Bids and Awards Committee, Philippine Ports Authority, Port Management Office- Bicol for the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 a. m. to 5:00 p.m.**, Monday to Friday.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents will be issued to the interested Bidders starting **January 20, 2021** from the address below and upon payment of non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P 25,000.00)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Philippine Ports Authority, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The Philippine Ports Authority- PMO-Bicol Bids and Awards Committee for Engineering Projects will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **January 28, 2021, 9:00 A.M.** at the Conference Room, PMO Administration Building, Regional Government Center, Rawis, Legazpi City, which shall be open to prospective bidders. All Interested parties who will participate in the Pre-bid Conference and Opening of Bid **should possess a proper authorization and company ID.**
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **9:00 A.M of February 9, 2021** at the Bids and Awards Committee, PMO Administration Building, Regional Government Center, Rawis, Legazpi City. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration in accordance with Section 27.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184.

Bid opening shall be on **February 9, 2021, 10:00 A.M** at the Conference Room, PMO Administration Building, Regional Government Center, Rawis, Legazpi City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

8. Required PCAB Registration: Small B – General Engineering (Port, Harbor and Offshore Engineering)

Submission of Company Profile is required for new interested bidders whose legal documents are not yet on file with the PMO-Bicol Bids and Awards Committee.

9. Equipment Required: 1 unit - Jackhammer with Compressor; 1 unit - Boomtruck; 1 unit; Backhoe (0.40cu.m 94.30hp); 1 unit – Breaker attachment; 1 unit - Dump Truck (8.00 cu.m) capacity; 1 unit - Crawler Crane; 1 unit - Vibro Hammer; 1 unit - Generator Set; 1 unit - Welding Machine; 1 unit - Oxy-Acetylene Cutting Outfit; 1 Unit - Bar Cutter; 1 unit - Bar Bender; 1 unit - 1 Bagger Concrete Mixer; 1 unit - Concrete Vibrator 3.5hp; 1 unit - Water truck with Pump; 1 unit - Road Grader 125hp; 1 unit – Road Roller (10T, vibratory); 1 unit – Concrete Cutter

The Philippine Ports Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
