



INVITATION TO BID

FOR THE:

**REPAIR OF TYPHOON DAMAGED BACK-UP AREA, RC PLATFORM AND
AND RORO RAMP NO. 2, PORT OF PIO DURAN, ALBAY
(CONTRACT NO. BCL 21-16)**

1. The **Philippine Ports Authority – Port Management Office of Bicol**, through the **PPA Corporate Budget of the Authority for CY 2021**, intends to apply the sum of **Thirty-Two Million Five Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos and Twenty Two Centavos (P 32,553,664.22)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Repair of Typhoon Damaged, Back-Up Area, RC Platform and RoRo Ramp No. 2, Port of Pio Duran, Albay**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Philippine Ports Authority- PMO-Bicol now invites bids for the following Scope of Works:

 - 2.06 Supply and Deliver To Site Rubber Dock Fenders (V-Type 500mm x 1500mm) with accessories
 - 2.07 Installation of Rubber Dock Fender (V-Type 500mm x 1500mm) with accessories
 - 2.08 Supply and Deliver To Site Rubber Dock Fenders with complete accessories
 - 2.09 Installation of 50T Mooring Bollard with complete accessories
 - 2.10 Supply and Install 100mm x 100mm x 10mm Hot Dipped Galvanized Angle Bar for Construction Joint
 - Item No.3 Back-Up Area**
 - 3.01 Demolition of Damaged Deflector Wall, RC Curb, Pavement and Removal of Paving Blocks
 - 3.02 Disposal of Demolished Deflector Wall, RC Curb and Pavement
 - 3.03 Excavation of Filling Materials up to desired Elevation prior to Installation of Geotextile Fabric
 - 3.04 Disposal of Excavated unsuitable Materials
 - 3.05 Supply and Install 50-100 kg. Core Rocks
 - 3.06 Supply and Install 1,000kg. Armour Rocks
 - 3.07 Supply and Install Geotextile Filter Fabric
 - 3.08 Supply, Place and Compact sand and Gravel Fill
 - 3.09 Supply, Place and Compact Selected Fill
 - 3.10 Supply, Place, and Compact Aggregate Base Course
 - 3.11 Supply and Place 3,500psi Concrete for Retaining Wall, RC Curb and Pavement
 - 3.12 Supply and Install Reinforcing Steel Bars for Retaining Wall, RC Curb, Pavement Dowel Bars
 - 3.13 Concrete Cutting, Curing and Protection

Completion of the Works is required in **Two Hundred Ten (210) Calendar Days**. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the major items of the project such as Item No. 2 & 3. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Equipment Required: 1 unit - Jackhammer with Compressor; 1 unit - Dump Truck (6.88-9.17 cu.m capacity) ; 1 unit - Backhoe (0.40cu.m 94.30hp); 1 unit - Truck Mounted Crane 35T; 1 Unit - Bar Cutter; 1 unit - Bar Bender; 2 unit - 1 Bagger Concrete Mixer; 2 unit - Concrete Vibrator 3.5hp ; 1 unit Concrete Cutter; 1 unit - Water truck with Pump; 1 unit Road Roller; 1 unit - Hydraulic Breaker ; 1 unit - Oxy/Acetylene Cutting Outfit; 1 unit Welding Machine with Generator Set; 1 unit Boom Truck (2.5T capacity)
4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary **“Pass/Fail”** criterion as also specified in the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

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5. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Bids and Awards Committee, Philippine Ports Authority, Port Management Office- Bicol for the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 a. m. to 5:00 p.m.**, Monday to Friday.
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents will be issued to the interested Bidders starting **October 25, 2021 to November 12, 2021** from the address below and upon presentation of payment of non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Twenty Five Thousand Pesos (P 25,000.00)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Philippine Ports Authority, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

7. The Philippine Ports Authority- PMO-Bicol Bids and Awards Committee for Engineering Projects will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **November 2, 2021, 2:00 P.M.** at the PPA Passenger Terminal Building, 2nd Floor, Baseport Legazpi City, which shall be open to prospective bidders. All Interested parties who will participate in the Pre-bid Conference and Opening of Bids **should possess a proper authorization and company ID**. Only one representative is allowed for every prospective bidder to attend the pre-bid conference and the opening of bids..
8. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **1:00 P.M of November 15, 2021** at the Bids and Awards Committee, PPA Passenger Terminal Building 2nd Floor, Baseport Legazpi City. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration in accordance with Section 27.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184.

Bid opening shall be on **November 15, 2021, 2:00 P.M** at the PPA Passenger Terminal Building, 2nd Floor, Baseport Legazpi City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.


9. Required PCAB Registration: Medium A – General Engineering (Port, Harbor and Offshore Engineering)

Submission of Company Profile is required for new interested bidders whose legal documents are not yet on file with the PMO-Bicol Bids and Awards Committee.

10. The Philippine Ports Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
