Bid opening shall be on **10:00AM of November 06, 2023** at PPA PMO-WLB Port Operation Ebony St., District 2, Port Area, Ormoc City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

The Philippine Ports Authority-, through the Corporate Budget of the Authority for CY 2023 intends to apply the sum of **One Million Five Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Three Hundred Five Pesos Only (Php1,552,305.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **Supply of Labor, Materials, and Parts for the Repair and Commissioning of Two (2) units 75KVA, Two (2) units 200KVA, One (1) unit 30KVA, and One (1) unit 500KVA Standby Power Generator, Cummins, Stamford Alternator Sets**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The Philippine Ports Authority Port Management Office – Western Leyte/Biliran (PPA PMO-WL/B) now invites bids for the **Supply of Labor, Materials, and Parts for the Repair and Commissioning of Two (2) units 75KVA, Two (2) units 200KVA, One (1) unit 30KVA, and One (1) unit 500KVA Standby Power Generator, Cummins, Stamford Alternator Sets**. Delivery of the goods is required **within 45 calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed**. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in **Section II Instructions to Bidders**.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.
