The Philippine Ports Authority (PPA), Port Management Office of Surigao, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for Procurement of Goods and Consultancy Services and for Engineering Projects, invites contractors registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) to bid for the hereunder contract:

Interested bidders **must present Original Copy of Special Power of Attorney (SPA)/Secretary’s Certificate** from the owner/corporation if done by a representative for the **entire procurement activities**. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Ten Thousand Pesos (**Php10,000.00**) inclusive of VAT.

Prospective bidders should possess a valid PCAB License and registration particulars applicable to the type and cost of the contract to be bid, have key personnel and equipment exclusively available for the prosecution of the contract as listed in Item C above, and must have completed a similar contract and with the same major categories of work as the contract to be bid and receipt of bids with a value of at least **50%** of the approved budget for the contract to be bid, updated to current prices using the NSO price indices, and must meet the other eligibility, technical/project, and financial requirements and other requirements stated in the Eligibility Statement Form and the Bidding Documents.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criteria as specified in the IRR of RA 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

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Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships or organizations with at least 75% interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The PPA, PMO-Surigao reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders. Similarly, the PPA PMO-Surigao assumes no responsibility, whatsoever, to compensate or indemnify the bidders of any expenses incurred in the preparation of their bids.
