Invitation to Bid

For the Repair for the Maintenance of Thirty-Five (35) Units Rubber Dock Fenders at Sasa Port Area Davao City

The Philippine Ports Authority — Port Management Office of Davao, through the Corporate Budget for the contract approved by the governing Board for CY 2017 intends to apply the sum of PESOS: Twenty-Eight Million Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Two and 78/100 only (\$\mathbb{P}\$ 28,009,382.78) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Repair for the Maintenance of Thirty-Five (35) Units Rubber Dock Fenders at Sasa Port Area, Davao City. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the bid opening.

The Philippine Ports Authority - Port Management Office of Davao through the BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE FOR ENGINEERING PROJECTS (BAC-EP) now invites bids for the Repair for the Maintenance of Thirty-Five (35) Units Rubber Dock Fenders at Sasa Port Area, Davao City. Completion of the Works is required to be within One Hundred Eighty (180) Calendar Days. Bidders must have an experience of having completed a Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) that is similar contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the PSA consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC to be bid: Provided, however that contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid maybe allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB.


Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Philippine Ports Authority – Port Management Office of Davao and inspect the Bidding Documents at its office at (Old-PDO Building) Km. 10, Port Area, Sasa, Davao City from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders at the Procuring Entity's given address and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of **Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php25,000.00)**.

The Philippine Ports Authority – Port Management Office of Davao Bids and Awards Committee for Engineering Projects will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference** on <u>May 2, 2017, 10:00</u> <u>A.M.</u> at **PPA- PMO Davao Conference Room (Old-PDO Building), Km. 10, Port Area Sasa, Davao City.** The Pre-Bid conference is open to prospective bidders but attendance shall not be mandatory.

Bids must be delivered on or before (deadline for the submission and receipt of bids) 8:00 A.M., May 15, 2017 at the PPA Port Management Office of Davao (Old-PDO Building), Km. 10, Port Area, Sasa, Davao City. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration OR Bid Security in any of the following acceptable forms and amount:

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the Procuring Entity's given address on May 15, 2017 at 9:30 A.M. Late bids shall not be accepted.

The Philippine Ports Authority – Port Management Office of Davao reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

- 5. Install HV Type Fender w/ Complete Accessories (SS Nuts and Bolts, Chains, Shackles, etc.)
- 6. Supply of Labor, Materials and Equipment for Steel Hanging Platform for Hole Drilling and Fender Installation
- 7. Supply of Labor, Materials and Equipment for Retouching of Quay Walls (for breakages and minor concrete damages)
