

Commission on Audit

It has the primary function to examine, audit and settle all accounts and expenditures of the funds and properties of the Philippine government. The Commission has the power, authority and duty to examine, audit and settle all accounts pertaining to the revenue and receipts of and expenditures or uses of the funds and properties of the Philippine government. Towards that end, it has the exclusive authority to define the scope, techniques and methods of its auditing and examination procedures. It also may prevent and disallow irregular, unnecessary, excessive, extravagant or unconscionable expenditures, or uses of government funds and properties.





Department of the Interior and Local

Interior and Local Government, abbreviated as DILG, is the executive department of the Philippine government responsible for promoting peace and order, ensuring public safety and strengthening local government capability aimed towards the effective delivery of basic services to the citizenry.






House of Representatives



The Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP) is the official organization of all Philippine lawyers whose names appear in the Roll of Attorneys of the Supreme Court.Republic Act No. 6397 confirmed the power of the Supreme Court to adopt rules of court to effect the integration of the Philippine Bar. Presidential Decree. No. 181 was promulgated on May 4, 1973 constituting the IBP into a body corporate and providing government assistance thereto for the accomplishment of its purposes.



The Legal Education Board was created pursuant to R.A. No. 7662, also Known as the Legal Education Reform Act of 1993. The law was approved by President Fidel V. Ramos on 23 December 1993. The primary policy of the law is to reform and uplift the standards of legal education in the country. Towards this end, the State shall undertake appropriate reforms in legal education, require proper selection of law students, maintain quality among law schools, and require legal apprenticeship and continuing legal education.






Book Publishing Industry Development Act, was a clear demonstration of the government's attention to the important role of books in nation building. The law created the National Book Development Board (NBDB) which is tasked primarily to formulate and implement a National Book Policy with a corresponding National Book Development Plan geared towards the development of the book publishing industry. Philippine government under the Department of Education formed through Republic Act No. 8047 or the Book Publishing Industry Development Act which was responsible for promoting the continuing development of the book publishing industry



The agency was created through Executive Order No. 125, s. 1993 which was later amended in 2001 with the signing of Executive Order No. 3, s. 2001 as a reaffirmation of the government's commitment to achieving just and lasting peace through a comprehensive peace process.




