Award of Contract for the PROCUREMENT OF TWENTY FIVE (25) UNITS OF BAGGAGE X-RAY MACHINES FOR PPA MANAGEMENT OFFICES BAC-PGCS-33-2017

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) advertised an Invitation to Bid for the Procurement of Twenty Five (25) Units of X-Ray Machines for PPA Management Offices, in the Manila Standard, a newspaper of general nationwide circulation on 27 November 2017 and posted the same in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and in the Bulletin Board located at the PPA Corporate Building, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as published/advertised is ₽ 200,000,000.00;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, five (5) prospective bidders secured the Bid Documents in the amount of ₽ 50,000.00, namely:

- 1. Casedist, Incorporated
- 2. Arktek System Builders, Inc./Safeway Inspection Limited/Joint Venture
- 3. Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Incorporated
- 4. Cylix Technologies, Incorporated/Advance Security & Safety Solutions. Incorporated/Joint Venture
- 5. Astrophysics, Incorporated/Astrophysics Asia, Incorporated/Genesis Transutnited, Incorporated/Joint Venture

WHEREAS, only four (4) bidders dropped their Technical and Financial Proposals, namely: Casedist, Inc.; Arktek System Builders, Inc./Safeway Inspection Limited/JV; Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc.; Cylix Technologies, Inc./Advance Security & Safety Solutions, Inc./JV. Astrophysics, Inc./Astrophysics Asia, Inc./Genesis Transunited, Inc./JV submitted its bid documents at 9:21 a.m. of 09 March 2018, or after the prescribed deadline for submission thereof, which was 9:00 a.m. The bid documents were not accepted by the BAC Secretariat, pursuant to the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 on late submission of bids:

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids on 09 March 2018 at 10:00 a.m., only Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc. was declared "passing" with the requirements of the First Envelope. Casedist, Inc.; Arktek System Builders, Inc./Safeway Inspection Limited/JV and Cylix Technologies, Inc./Advance Security & Safety Solutions, Inc./JV were declared "failed" and signified their intensions to file their respective requests for reconsideration, however no requests for reconsideration were filed within the prescribed deadline for filing thereof;

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposal of Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc. was opened and declared "passing" with the requirements of the Second Envelope, hence its financial bid was read by the Chairperson, as follows:

WHEREAS, Bid Evaluation was conducted on 16 March 2018 to determine if there were arithmetical or computational errors on the submitted bid, and the Bid Evaluation Report, as approved by the BAC on 19 March 2018, showed no discrepancies between the Total Bid Prices and Unit Bid Prices of Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc.;

WHEREAS, Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc. was declared as the Single Calculated Bidder in the amount of ₽ 189,888,000.00;

WHEREAS, post-qualification was conducted on 02 April 2018 to examine, validate and verify the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc. and in the Post-Qualification Report, as approved by the BAC on 04 April 2018, Defense and Protection Systems Philippines, Inc. was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to declare **DEFENSE AND PROTECTION SYSTEMS PHILIPPINES, INCORPORATED** as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder and to recommend the award of contract for the Procurement of Twenty Five (25) Units of Baggage X-Ray Machines for PPA Management Offices, in the amount of **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY NINE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (P 189,888,000.00),** inclusive of taxes, to the said bidder.


