WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) advertised an Invitation to Bid for the Proposed Construction of Port Operations Building, Port of Dumaguete, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, in the Manila Standard, a newspaper of general nationwide circulation on 22 March 2018 and posted the same in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and in the Bulletin Board located at the PPA Corporate Building, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as published/advertised is **₱ 112,670,064.39**;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, only A5R Dynamics Const. Corp. secured and submitted the Bid Documents in the amount of ₱ 50,000.00;

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids on 17 April 2018 at 10:00 a.m., A5R Dynamics Const. Corp. was declared "passing" with the requirements of the First Envelope;

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposal of A5R Dynamics Const. Corp. was opened and declared "passing" with the requirements of the Second Envelope, hence its financial bid was read by the Chairperson, as follows:

WHEREAS, Bid Evaluation was conducted on 20 April 2018 to determine if there were arithmetical or computational errors on the submitted bid, and the Bid Evaluation Report, as approved by the BAC on 23 April 2018, showed discrepancies between the Total Bid Prices and Unit Bid Prices of A5R Dynamics Const. Corp.;






