WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) advertised an Invitation to Bid for the Proposed Construction of RC Wharf Extension, Port of Lilooy, Lamao, Zamboanga del Norte, in the Manila Standard, a newspaper of general nationwide circulation on 22 March 2018 and posted the same in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and in the Bulletin Board located at the PPA Corporate Building, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as published/advertised is **₱ 63,789,567.78**;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement four (4) bidders secured and submitted the Bid Documents in the amount of ₱ 50,000.00, namely:

1. RCDG Construction Corporation
2. Victoriano C. Lim Construction
3. Mamsar Construction & Industrial Corporation
4. RT Crisman Builders and Construction Supply

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids on 18 April 2018 at 10:00 a.m., only three (3) bidders were declared "passing" with the requirements of the First Envelope, namely: RCDG Const. Corp., Victoriano C. Lim Const. and RT Crisman Builders & Const. Supply. Mamsar Const. & Industrial Corp. was declared "failed" hence, its Second Envelope was returned unopened and duly received by its authorized representative after signifying no intention to file a request for reconsideration;

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposals of the three (3) bidders were opened and declared "passing" with the requirements of the Second Envelope, hence their financial bids were read by the Chairperson, as follows:

VISION

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By 2020, PPA shall have provided globally competitive port services in the Philippines characterized by increased productivity, efficiency, connectivity, comfort, safety, security and environmental sustainability.

MISSION

1. Provide reliable and responsive services in ports, sustain development of communities and the environment, and be a model corporate agency of the government.

WHEREAS, Bid Evaluation was conducted on 20 April 2018 to determine if there were arithmetical or computational errors on the submitted bids, and the Bid Evaluation Report, as approved by the BAC on 23 April 2018, showed discrepancies between the Total Bid Prices and Unit Bid Prices of the three (3) bidders;



WHEREAS, despite said discrepancies, the ranking of the three (3) bidders were not affected, hence RCDG Const. Corp. was declared as the Lowest Calculated Bidder in the amount of ₱ 62,350,758.84, pursuant to Section 34.4 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, post-qualification was conducted on 27 April 2018 to examine, validate and verify the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by RCDG Const. Corp. and in the Post-Qualification Report, as approved by the BAC on 30 April 2018, RCDG Const. Corp. was declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to declare **RCDG CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder and to recommend the award of contract for the Proposed Construction of RC Wharf Extension, Port of Liloy, Lamao, Zamboanga del Norte, in the amount of **SIXTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT AND 84/100 PESOS (₱ 62,350,758.84)**, inclusive of taxes, to the said bidder.


