**RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE SUPPLY AND
DELIVERY OF BODY WORN CAMERAS (PHASE II)**
BAC-PGCS-033-2021

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) posted an Invitation to Bid for the Supply and Delivery of Body Worn Cameras (Phase II), in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and in the Bulletin Board located at the PPA Corporate Building, South Harbor, Port Area, Manila, on 06 May 2021, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as posted/advertised is **₱ 170,000,000.00**;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, only Boston Home, Inc. secured the Bid Documents in the amount of **₱ 50,000.00** and submitted its Technical and Financial Proposals;

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids on 03 June 2021 at 10:00 a.m., the lone bidder, Boston Home, Inc. was declared "failed" in the requirements of the First Envelope for the following reasons:

1. Failure to provide any proof that the signatory in the Bid Securing Declaration is authorized to sign in behalf of Boston Home, Inc.
2. Failure to submit an Omnibus Sworn Statement.
3. Failure to submit a Certification that the bidder will provide Live Streaming Software & Evidence Management Licenses.
4. Failure to submit a Certification that the bidder has one (1) service center in the Philippines.

WHEREAS, Boston Home, Inc. signified no intention to file a request for reconsideration;

WHEREAS, considering that the lone bidder was declared "failed, the BAC, after a motion duly made and properly seconded, declared the bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Body Worn Cameras (Phase II), a failure, pursuant to Section 35.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, which provides, to wit:

“35.1 The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when:

xxx xxx xxx

b) All prospective bidders are declared ineligible;

xxx xxx xxx.”

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend the following:

1. To recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity that the bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Body Worn Cameras (Phase II), be declared a “failure” pursuant to Section 35.1 (a) of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A 9184.
2. To conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/ or posting, as provided for in Section 21.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184



SUBJECT : **Resolution Declaring Failure of Bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Body Worn Cameras (Phase II)**
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This has reference to the Opening of Bids for the Supply and Delivery of Body Worn Cameras (Phase II), held on 03 June 2021, which was declared by the BAC as "failure of bidding" pursuant to Section 35.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, which states that: "The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when: b) All prospective bidders are declared ineligible."

In view thereof, we are submitting herewith BAC-PGCS Resolution No. 033-2021 Series of 2021, recommending that the bidding for the above project be declared a "failure" pursuant to Section 35.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 and to conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/or posting, as provided for in Section 21.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, for consideration and approval of the General Manager as Head of the Procuring Entity.
