Award of Contract for the
**TABLAS (POCTOY) PORT EXPANSION PROJECT, PORT OF
 TABLAS (POCTOY), ODIONGAN, ROMBLON**
 LFP BGS NO. 032-2019

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) posted an Invitation to Bid for the Tablas (Poctoy) Port Expansion Project, Port of Tablas (Poctoy), Odiongan, Romblon, in the website of the PPA, PhilGEPS and in the Bulletin Board located at the PPA Corporate Building, South Harbor, Port Area, Manila on 25 October 2019, continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract to be Bid as posted/advertised is **₱ 149,513,733.91**;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, three (3) bidders secured and submitted the Bid Documents in the amount of ₱ 50,000.00, namely:

1. Khan Kon Chi Construction and Development Corporation
2. MRBII Construction Corporation
3. Sunwest Construction & Development Corporation

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids on 19 November 2019 at 10:00 a.m., the three (3) bidders were declared "passing" with the requirements of the First Envelope;

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposal of the three (3) bidders were opened, hence their financial bids were read by the Chairperson, as follows:

1. MRBII CONST. CORP.	₱ 147,488,603.62
2. SUNWEST CONST. & DEV'T. CORP.	₱ 149,277,572.31
3. KHAN KON CHI CONST. AND DEV'T. CORP.	₱ 149,464,152.54 (Did not include Reimbursable Items in the Pay Items of Work)

WHEREAS, the Financial Proposal of Sunwest Const. & Dev't. Corp. and MRBII Const. Corp. were declared "passing" with the requirements of the Second Envelope, however Khan Kon Chi Const. was declared "failed" for submitting an incomplete bid proposal. As prescribed in Section 30.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, which explicitly states, that: xxx. "In case any of the requirements in the second envelope of a particular bid is missing, incomplete or patently insufficient, and/or if the submitted total bid price exceeds the ABC, the BAC shall rate the bid concerned as "failed;"

WHEREAS, in a letter dated 19 November 2019, Khan Kon Chi Const. and Dev't. Corp. informed the BAC that they will not file a Motion for Reconsideration on their "failed" rating;


WHEREAS, Bid Evaluation was conducted on 21 November 2019 to determine if there were arithmetical or computational errors on the submitted bid, and the Bid Evaluation Report, as approved by the BAC on 22 November 2019, showed no discrepancies between the Total Bid Prices and Unit Bid Prices of MRBII Const. Corp., however the submitted Bill of Quantities (BOQ) of Sunwest Const. & Dev't. Corp., differs from the required quantity reflected in the BOQ of the Bid Documents. Clause 15.2 Section II of the Instructions to Bidders provides "that the bidders shall fill in rates and prices for all items of the works prescribed in the Bill of Quantities. Bids not addressing or providing all of the required items in the Bidding Documents including, where applicable, Bill of Quantities, shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.";

WHEREAS, MRBII Const. Corp. was declared as the Single Calculated Bidder in the amount of ₱ 147,488,603.62;

WHEREAS, post-qualification was conducted on 26 November 2019 to examine, validate and verify the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by MRBII Const. Corp. and in the Post-Qualification Report, as approved by the BAC on 29 November 2019, MRBII Const. Corp. was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to declare **MRBII CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION** as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder and to recommend the award of contract for the Tablas (Poctoy) Port Expansion Project, Port of Tablas (Poctoy), Odiongan, Romblon, in the amount of **ONE HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THREE AND 62/100 PESOS (₱ 147,488,603.62)**, inclusive of taxes, to the said bidder.
