Wharf, Mooring and Fendering System and Back-up Area, Port of Coron, Coron, Palawan in The Manila Times on December 8, 2017 and posted the same in Phil-GEPS and PPA websites and at the bulletin board of PMO-Palawan continuously for seven (7) days from December 8-14, 2017;

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisement, only one (1) prospective bidder/contractor secured and purchased bid documents namely:

WHEREAS, BCT TRADING AND CONSTRUCTION, submitted a letter on non-participation on December 29, 2017 at 8:25 A.M. due to unavailability of key personnel for the contract to be bid;

NOW THEREFORE, for in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PMO-Palawan Bids and Award Committee hereby resolves, as it hereby resolves, to declare the Bidding of NRP-PLW-03-2017 Repair of R.C. Wharf, Mooring and Fendering System and Back-up Area, Port of Coron, Coron, Palawan a FAILURE;
