Busuanga, Palawan**


WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority, PMO-Palawan advertised the Re-Invitation to Bid for the Busuanga Port Development Project, Port of Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan in The Manila Times on April 5, 2017 and posted the same in Phil-GEPS and PPA websites and at the bulletin board of PMO-Palawan continuously for seven (7) days from April 5-11, 2017;

WHEREAS, there were no prospective bidder/contractor who purchased bid documents until the published deadline of submission of bid/s on April 27, 2017 at 8:30 A.M.;


NOW THEREFORE, for the consideration of the foregoing premises, the PMO-Palawan Bids and Award Committee hereby resolves, as it hereby resolves, to declare for the 2nd time the Bidding of the Busuanga Port Development, Port of Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan as FAILURE;
