Declaring as Failure the Negotiated Procurement of the Busuanga Port Development Project, Port of Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority PMO-Palawan advertised the Invitation for Negotiated Procurement for the Busuanga Port Development Project, Port of Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan in the Phil-GEPS and PPA websites and at the bulletin board of PMO-Palawan continuously for seven (7) days from September 11-17, 2017;

WHEREAS, aside from the posting and advertisement of the invitation, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited three (3) contractors for the project, for negotiations, namely:


1. ORIENT STAR CONSTRUCTION, INC.
2. J.C.PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC.
3. MRBII CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2017 at 9:00 A.M., the published deadline of submission of documents, there were no prospective bidders/contractors participated in the negotiations process but instead the BAC received letters from the abovementioned invited contractors not to participate in the negotiated procurement (copy of letters attached);



RESOLVED FURTHER, to recommend to the Acting Port Manager of PMO-Palawan, the head of the procuring entity, to inform the Assistant General Manager for Engineering regarding the failure of negotiated procurement conducted by the PMO-Palawan Bids and Awards Committee and to respectfully inform Department of Transportation (DOTr) for its appropriate action and consideration the result of the procurement process, as provided for under RA 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR.
