Declaring the Bid of J.C. PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC. as the Single Calculated Responsive Bid for the REPAIR OF DAMAGED R.C. WHARF, CONCRETE PAVEMENT CRACKS AND CONSTRUCTION JOINTS AND REPLACEMENT OF DILAPIDATED RUBBER DOCK FENDERS AT RORO RAMP, PORT OF PUERTO PRINCESA, PALAWAN and Recommending Approval Thereof, and Recommending Award of Contract

WHEREAS, the Philippine Ports Authority – PMO-Palawan advertised and posted the Invitation to Bid for the *Repair of Damaged R.C. Wharf, Concrete Pavement Cracks and Construction Joints and Replacement of Dilapidated Rubber Dock Fenders at Roro Ramp, Port of Puerto Princesa, Palawan* in the PPA and Phil-GEPS Websites and at the bulletin board of PMO – Palawan continuously for seven (7) days from November 03 to 09, 2016;

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisement, two (2) prospective bidders purchased bid documents, namely:

1. TEDDIE CONSTRUCTION DEVELOPMENT, INC.
2. J.C. PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC.

WHEREAS, J.C. PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC. submitted its Bid, in sealed envelope, while the Bid of TEDDIE CONSTRUCTION DEVELOPMENT, INC. was not accepted by the BAC Secretariat due to late submission within published deadline;

WHEREAS, at 9:12 A.M. on November 21, 2016 the bid of J.C. PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC. was opened and “*passed*” the preliminary examination of bid, and the result is tabulated as follow:



- c) To recommend award of contract of the subject project to J.C. PIÑON CONSTRUCTION INC. in its bid amount of ₱ 12,497,805.05.




